To Whom It May Concern,

In my practice of Internal Medicine, I have had the opportunity to prescribe Microcurrent therapy for a variety of musculoskeletal problems. I have found this treatment to be very useful for control of the acute pain, especially strains and sprains, and helping restore function and range of motion in acute and subacute conditions. I have also personally been treated for musculoskeletal pain including neck spasm, shoulder pains, low back pain, and pelvic floor pain. I, too, have found it personally very effective in reducing pain, keeping me active, and maintaining function.

I will continue using it personally and prescribe it to my patients. I believe it would be an asset to any private practice or hospital physical therapy program and recommend its use at Maui Memorial Hospital. I feel that to ensure quality of treatments, a license from a state technical school should be required for the therapists and favor creation of a licensing procedure and examination for this therapy.
