Our use of the Electro-Acuscope at the UCLA Pain Management Center has continued to show that it is a very effective treatment modality for the relief of chronic pain. We have found that the electrical stimulation of specific regions of myofascial pain with the Electro-Acuscope produces immediate and pronounced relief of pain and tension. This instrument has been found in our clinic to produce significantly greater reduction of tension and discomfort than other transcutaneous electrical nerve stimulation instruments. The Acuscope has the further advantage that it is useful for the stimulation of ear acupuncture and body acupuncture points, in addition to the treatment of local regions of body discomfort. It is an important component in the multidisciplinary treatment of chronic pain.
